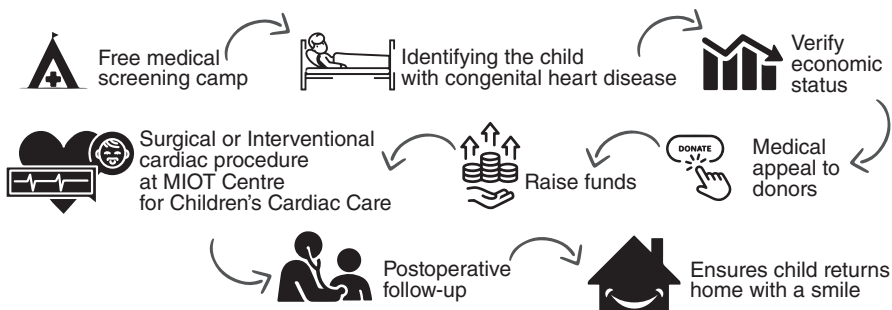

We Identify Children In Need Of Cardiac Care

Knowing that every moment counts when it comes to cardiac issues in children, CHIME does not wait for a child to become critically ill or require emergency medical attention. Instead, we actively go into communities to identify children with cardiac conditions before they show symptoms or reach a critical stage.

Our doctors visit various districts in Tamil Nadu, coordinating with the District Early Intervention Centres (DEIC) and Primary Health Centres (PHC) of Tamil Nadu Government to conduct Free Medical Screening Camps. The children are examined and those in need of cardiac care are treated at the MIOT Centre for Children's Cardiac Care.

What is Congenital Heart Disease?

Congenital heart defects are abnormalities in the heart's chambers, valves or blood vessels present from birth. They may manifest at different ages. A baby may be born with only one or several defects; some complex, severe defects are evident within a few hours or days of birth and require early intervention (surgery/procedure).

These children may manifest with one or more of the following symptoms: rapid breathing, feeding difficulty, poor weight gain, recurrent respiratory infections, easy fatiguability, fainting, bluish discolouration of fingers, toes, tongue, etc.

In India, about 1 in 110 babies are born with congenital heart disease, amounting to an estimated 200,000 children each year. About one-fifth of these cases suffer from critical heart disease requiring early intervention.



Impact on Low-Income Families

Congenital Heart Disease poses a substantial financial burden on low socio-economic status groups. In addition to the financial constraints, less access to healthcare, and lack of knowledge on disease diagnosis, and management act as a barrier for the economically deprived people in receiving the treatment.

MIOT Centre for Children's Cardiac Care

The MIOT Centre for Children's Cardiac Care offers specialised treatment for children with congenital heart diseases. Equipped with state-of-the-art technology including 3D and fetal echocardiography, MRI and MR angiography, a catheterisation lab, and a paediatric cardiac ICU, the Centre provides comprehensive cardiac care for children. Procedures include catheter interventions for heart defects, neonatal cardiac surgery, minimally invasive cardiac surgery, valve repairs, and corrective surgery for 'blue babies', which are performed by our experts.

MIOT's team of specialists, with over 30 years of experience, includes a paediatrician, paediatric cardiac surgeon, interventional cardiologist, paediatric surgeon, paediatric anaesthetist, intensivist, and nurses specialised in paediatric care.
